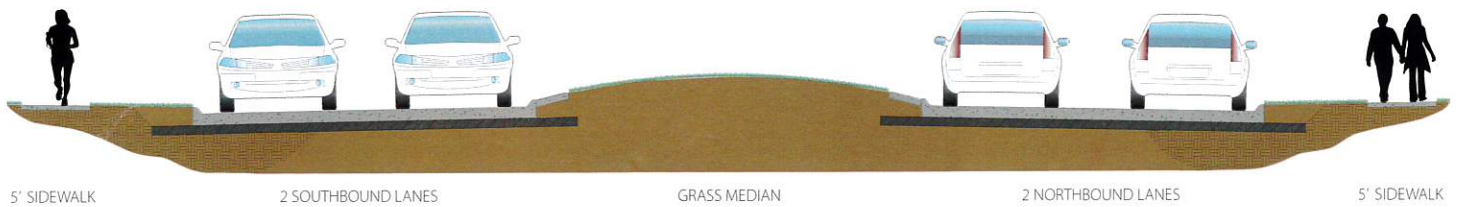

168th Street

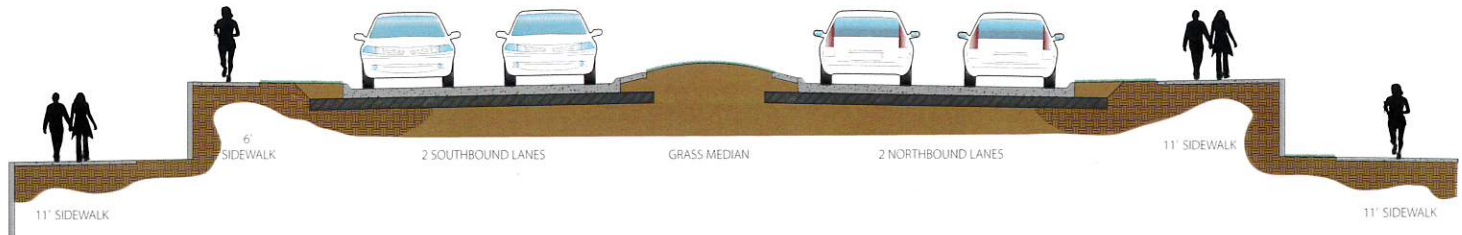
(TYPICAL 4 LANE SECTION WITH 16' MEDIAN)

About the Project

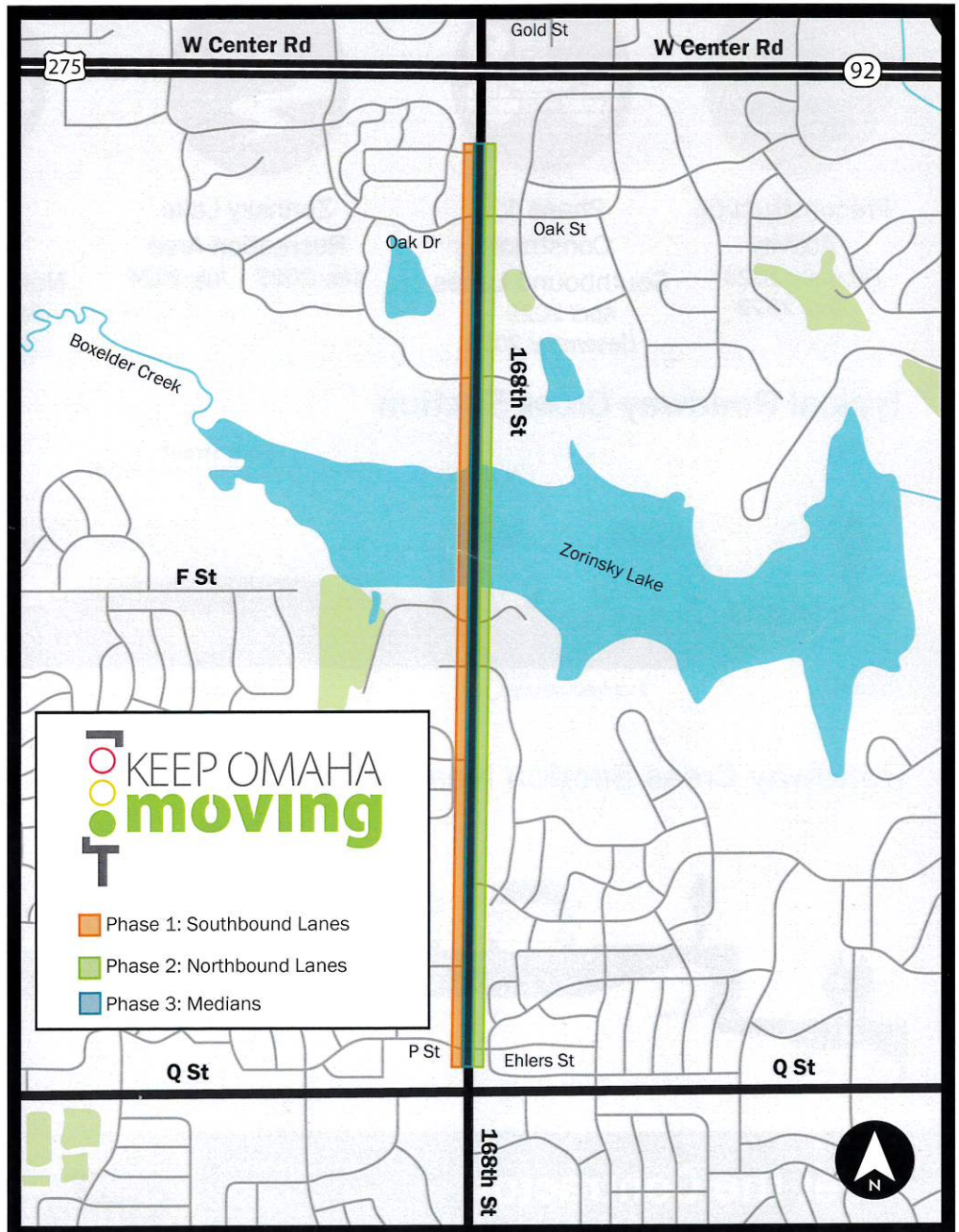
168th Street between West Center Road and Q Street is planned to be reconstructed to a four-lane roadway divided by a median.

Project Benefits

-  Improve safety
-  Increase capacity
-  Enhance traffic operations
-  Improve pedestrian accessibility

Project improvements include:

- Widening 168th Street to 4-lane divided urban section
- Improving bridge conditions
- Adding new center turn lanes and traffic signals
- Improving pedestrian accessibility by connecting the sidewalk and bicycle network



168th Street traffic will be maintained during construction. Access to Zorinsky Lake Trail across the bridge, as well as boat access under the bridge, will be closed. Trail access will be maintained across 168th Street at the north and south entrances to the park. Construction will continue through 2024.

Zorinsky Lake Recreation Area is bounded by South Lake Drive and North Lake Drive. Pedestrian access across the bridge will be closed during construction, however, temporary crossing of 168th Street will be allowed during this closure. All three phases of construction must be complete within 18 months, based on the environmental commitment. Portions of phases one through three that are beyond South Lake Drive and North Lake Drive may be completed outside this window.
